Subject: Notes from the HCHY Committee Meeting

1. Secretary's Report: The minutes from the 10/20/07 meeting were passed around.
2. Financial Report: Dale Panovich reported a balance of \$1,806.65 in the checking account.
3. Youth Committee Report: 15 youth committee members went to the Haunted House and had a meeting afterwards at McDonalds. Committee will encourage the high school to use the wooden coins. Craft Show 12/1/07 at CHS with proceeds going to Virgil Walker Scholarship Fund. Copley Idol show was cancelled. Team Building will be in January 2008 with Ned Parks who is a professional consultant that brings life lessons to youth – more information to follow. Youth committee will consider visiting Chambrel and other nursing facilities during the upcoming holidays. Youth committee is in the process of nominations for officers and will vote in January 2008.
