Business Meeting:

1. Secretary Report. The minutes from the March 17, 2007 meeting were passed around. Thank you to Jeanne Sabet for the March 17, 2007 minutes. Ned Parks did a really nice job speaking at the last meeting. Internet safety presentation April 23, 2007 was very good and included how to monitor the kids on My Space.
