Subject: Notes from the HCHY Adult Committee and Youth Members' Meeting

1. The Minutes from the 1/27/07 HCHY meeting were passed around. The new secretary will be Cathy Hochever. Suggestions will be welcome for restructuring the HCHY meetings. Think about it.
2. The Treasurer's Report was given by Dale Panovich. There is a balance of \$2969.47. \$2,000 was raised from the Chili Dinner for the Loren Scholarship Foundation. The Goal is to raise \$10,000. More later about attempts to get matching funds.
